JUDICIAL SELECTION COMMISSION, STATE OF HAWAI‘I
DEADLINE EXTENDED FOR NOMINATIONS OR APPLICATIONS
FOR THE ANTICIPATED VACANCY IN JUDICIAL OFFICE

The Judicial Selection Commission is extending the deadline for nominations and applications for the anticipated vacancy in the judicial office of Chief Justice, Supreme Court of Hawai‘i, to allow interested persons additional time to submit nominations and applications.

The Constitution of the State of Hawai ‘i requires that persons selected by the Commission be residents and citizens of the State of Hawai ‘i and of the United States , and licensed to practice law by the Hawai‘i Supreme Court. A justice of the supreme court shall have been so licensed for a period of not less than ten years preceding nomination.

The Commission invites anyone interested to nominate individuals who meet the constitutional requirements. **Nominations** should be mailed to the Commission’s office as soon as possible and **not later than Tuesday, October 20, 2009.**
