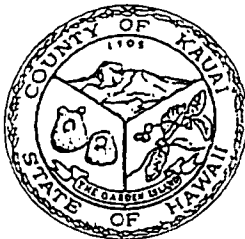

SUBJECT: NOTICE OF GRADING VIOLATION
FOR TMK: 5-1-002:001

We observed and verified the grading on the subject property to be in violation of the County's Revised Code of Ordinance, Title VIII, Chapter 22, Article 7, "An Ordinance Regulating and Controlling Grading, Grubbing, and Stockpiling and Soil Erosion and Sedimentation within the County of Kauai." The violation is as follows:

1. Grading in excess of 100 cubic yard without a permit.

You are required to comply with the following:

1. Inform your contractor to stop work immediately with the exception of work to correct any hazards to public safety and health.
2. You are advised to provide temporary and remedial mitigative measures to correct erosion and sedimentation problems that may or have occurred.

Please note that you may be liable for damages that have or may occur as a result of the above grading work. We therefore recommend your earliest attention to this matter.

For your convenience and use, we are enclosing a grading permit application and a brief handout which explains our permit procedures.

I was summoned by Mayor Kusaka along with Mr. Wallace Kudo (who was not available) to her office for a meeting. The parties present were; 1) Mayor Maryanne Kusaka, 2) Assistant Administrator Mr. Wallace Rezentes, Sr., 3) County Engineer Mr. Cesar Portugal, and 4) Civil engineer I Mr S. John Buist Jr..

The subject of our conversation was the grading violation for a Mr. James Pfluger on TMK: 5-1-02:01. The question was ask as to who complained about the grading/grubbing work taking place on the above mentioned parcel. I informed the Mayor that we received an anonymous phone call and responded with an investigative report. I also informed her that the inspector (who's name was not requested) took a picture from a distance of the equipment being used for the work and the cut mountain top because the site was inaccessible. I was questioned as to why we responded to an anonymous phone call and responded that it was our procedure to respond with an investigation. She questioned as to the wasted manhours to follow up on anonymous tips and that no other County Agencies responded to anonymous tips. Mr. Rezentes said that he would contact Mr. Kitabayashi and discuss our current policy on anonymous phone calls.

Mayor Kusaka asked whether Mr. Pfluger had applied for a grading permit. I informed her that Mr. Pfluger had indeed submitted a grubbing permit application on 10/22/97 but failed to submit any grubbing plans with the application. Ms. Yolanda Portugal-Cabral submitted a reduced TMK map with a highlighted area for the grubbing work location only on 11/12/97. In the interim, a complaint was received and an investigation performed on 11/7/97, at which point the grading of the hilltop and the presence of heavy equipment was documented. On or about November 16, 1997, a second complaint was received from a Mr. Larry Perkin and the grading

violation was issued for Mr. Pfluger.

Mr. Rezentes questioned the intent of the Grading Ordinance. His concern was that if Mr. Pfluger is grubbing only four(4) acres on a parcel of land that is over 100 acres and the site is located in a remote area, why should Mr. Pfluger be required to obtain a grubbing permit. The Mayor Agreed with him and doesn't understand why people can't do as they please on these large parcels of land, especially if it is for agriculture use. He also questioned what the difference is between grubbing work and grading work. I informed him that the grubbing permit had not been issued and was required prior to the grubbing of 4 acres of land per the Grading Ordinance no matter how remote the grubbing site is. I mentioned that Mr. Pfluger may be able to obtain an agricultural exemption for his "tree farm" if he contacts the Natural Resource Conservation Services, Mr. Ron Payton, and obtains an approved active conservation plan. I explained to Mr. Rezentes that grubbing work is the removal of the root structure of the existing vegetation and that grading was the alteration of the existing ground elevations, which influences natural drainage patterns. I also informed him that this was not the first violation for which Mr. Pfluger has been cited.

In closing, Mr Portugal instructed me that I was to stop all actions involving Mr. Pfluger and all further communications from or to Mr. Pfluger are to go directly to Mr. Portugal.

Re: Violation of grading ordinance for TMK 5-1-02:01 (Pflueger Mauka)

On July 2, 2002, County Attorney Hartwell Blake questioned me regarding a conversation that was held with John Buist on or around November 26, 1997. I explained to Hartwell that I recalled asking Mr. Buist about procedures for responding to complaints in the Engineering Division. I was particularly concerned with the Division's policy regarding anonymous complaints. The reason for my concern was that in recent weeks, we had received anonymous complaints about possible grading violations on Mr. Pflueger's property, and I had also received a phone call from Mr. Pflueger, who was angry about a violation notice he had received. Mr. Pflueger felt he had a right to know who was filing the complaint.

Previous to this incident, I had been advised that staff from Engineering routinely sends out inspectors to follow up on anonymous complaints. I was also aware that oftentimes, the inspector responds, only to find that there is no access available to the subject property, no one present to question about the matter, and visual inspections often reveal no illegal activity. I believe that this is a waste of County resources, and told Mr. Buist that I felt a complainant should be willing to provide his or her name if in fact the complaint was legitimate. My intent was twofold: 1) to better understand our policy regarding anonymous complaints, and 2) to support our staff and insure that they are making the best use of their time.

This is in response to your letter dated July 29, 2002 in regards to the proposed Erosion Control Plan for the south side of Kaloko Reservoir. We reviewed the subject Erosion Control Plan and offer the following comments:

A. Erosion Control Plan:

1. A typical detail of the silt fence installation needs to be shown on your erosion control plan.
2. The location of the silt fence installation needs to be shown on your erosion control plan.
3. Our Planning Department is the designated as the responsible agency for coordinating and processing of construction plans and permits. Please contact them at 241-6677 for a Clearing House Determination. Please note that all agency concerns needs to be addressed prior to obtaining an after the fact grading permit.
4. Since we have not observed the previous grading operations that was done in 1997 and the recent grading in July 2002, we request that a soils engineer be retained to provided certification that all grading activities complies with the grading ordinance no 695. The soils engineer also needs to be retained to monitor and test the remedial compact work on the southerly side of Kaloko Reservoir prior to grassing of the bared areas.
5. The erosion control plan needs to provide temporary and permanent erosion

control measures as well as temporary dust control measures.

6. The erosion control plans needs to be implemented as soon as possible to mitigate Silt runoffs into the reservoir and adjacent drainage areas. We request a construction schedule as to when the silt fence will be installed and when the Remedial compaction work will be done as well as the final irrigation and grassing of the bared areas. We also request a time schedule of events as to when we can expect the after the fact grading plans will be submitted for our approval.
